Matthew 10:13	If the household is worthy, let your peace come upon it. But if it is not worthy, let your peace return to you.
Matthew 10:34	“Do not think that I came to bring peace on earth. I did not come to bring peace but a sword.
Mark 4:39	Then He arose and rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, “Peace, be still!” And the wind ceased and there was a great calm.
Mark 5:34	And He said to her, “Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction.”
Mark 9:50	Salt <i>is</i> good, but if the salt loses its flavor, how will you season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have peace with one another.”
Luke 1:79	To give light to those who sit in darkness and the shadow of death, To guide our feet into the way of peace.”
Luke 2:14	“Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!”
Luke 2:29	“Lord, now You are letting Your servant depart in peace, According to Your word;
Luke 7:50	Then He said to the woman, “Your faith has saved you. Go in peace.”
Luke 8:48	And He said to her, “Daughter, be of good cheer; your faith has made you well. Go in peace.”
Luke 10:5	But whatever house you enter, first say, ‘Peace to this house.’
Luke 10:6	And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it; if not, it will return to you.
Luke 11:21	When a strong man, fully armed, guards his own palace, his goods are in peace.
Luke 12:51	Do <i>you</i> suppose that I came to give peace on earth? I tell you, not at all, but rather division.
Luke 14:32	Or else, while the other is still a great way off, he sends a delegation and asks conditions of peace.
Luke 19:38	saying: “ ‘Blessed is <i>the King who comes in the name of the Lord!</i> ’ Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!”
Luke 19:42	saying, “If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things <i>that make</i> for your peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes.
Luke 24:36	Now as they said these things, Jesus Himself stood in the midst of them, and said to them, “Peace to you.”
John 14:27	Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.
John 16:33	These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.”
John 20:19	Then, the same day at evening, being the first <i>day</i> of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in the midst, and said to them, “Peace <i>be</i> with you.”
John 20:21	So Jesus said to them again, “Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you.”
John 20:26	And after eight days His disciples were again inside, and Thomas with them. Jesus came, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, “Peace to you!”
Acts 9:31	Then the churches throughout all Judea, Galilee, and Samaria had peace and were edified. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, they were multiplied.
Acts 10:36	The word which <i>God</i> sent to the children of Israel, preaching peace through Jesus Christ—He is Lord of all—
Acts 12:20	Now Herod had been very angry with the people of Tyre and Sidon; but they came to him with one accord, and having made Blastus the king’s personal aide their friend, they asked for peace, because their country was supplied with food by the king’s <i>country</i> .
Acts 16:36	So the keeper of the prison reported these words to Paul, saying, “The magistrates have sent to let you go. Now therefore depart, and go in peace.”
Acts 24:2	And when he was called upon, Tertullus began his accusation, saying: “Seeing that through you we enjoy great peace, and prosperity is being brought to this nation by your foresight,
Romans 1:7	To all who are in Rome, beloved of God, called <i>to be</i> saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
Romans 2:10	but glory, honor, and peace to everyone who works what is good, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Romans 3:17	<i>And the way of peace they have not known."</i>
Romans 5:1	Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
Romans 8:6	For to be carnally minded <i>is</i> death, but to be spiritually minded <i>is</i> life and peace.
Romans 10:15	And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: " <i>How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, Who bring glad tidings of good things!</i> "
Romans 14:17	for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.
Romans 14:19	Therefore let us pursue the things <i>which make</i> for peace and the things by which one may edify another.
Romans 15:13	Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
Romans 15:33	Now the God of peace <i>be</i> with you all. Amen.
Romans 16:20	And the God of peace will crush Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ <i>be</i> with you. Amen.
1 Corinthians 1:3	Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
1 Corinthians 7:15	But if the unbeliever departs, let him depart; a brother or a sister is not under bondage in such <i>cases</i> . But God has called us to peace.
1 Corinthians 14:33	For God is not <i>the author</i> of confusion but of peace, as in all the churches of the saints.
1 Corinthians 16:11	Therefore let no one despise him. But send him on his journey in peace, that he may come to me; for I am waiting for him with the brethren.
2 Corinthians 1:2	Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
2 Corinthians 13:11	Finally, brethren, farewell. Become complete. Be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you.
Galatians 1:3	Grace to you and peace from God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ,
Galatians 5:22	But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,
Galatians 6:16	And as many as walk according to this rule, peace and mercy <i>be</i> upon them, and upon the Israel of God.
Ephesians 1:2	Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
Ephesians 2:14	For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation,
Ephesians 2:15	having abolished in His flesh the enmity, <i>that is</i> , the law of commandments <i>contained</i> in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man <i>from</i> the two, <i>thus</i> making peace,
Ephesians 2:17	And He came and preached peace to you who were afar off and to those who were near.
Ephesians 4:3	endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
Ephesians 6:15	and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace;
Ephesians 6:23	Peace to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
Philippians 1:2	Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
Philippians 4:7	and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
Philippians 4:9	The things which you learned and received and heard and saw in me, these do, and the God of peace will be with you.
Colossians 1:2	To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ <i>who are</i> in Colosse: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
Colossians 1:20	and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross.
Colossians 3:15	And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful.
1 Thessalonians 1:1	Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Thessalonians 5:3	For when they say, "Peace and safety!" then sudden destruction comes upon them, as labor pains upon a pregnant woman. And they shall not escape.
1 Thessalonians 5:13	and to esteem them very highly in love for their work's sake. Be at peace among yourselves.
1 Thessalonians 5:23	Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
2 Thessalonians 1:2	Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
2 Thessalonians 3:16	Now may the Lord of peace Himself give you peace always in every way. The Lord <i>be</i> with you all.
1 Timothy 1:2	To Timothy, a true son in the faith: Grace, mercy, <i>and</i> peace from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.
2 Timothy 1:2	To Timothy, a beloved son: Grace, mercy, <i>and</i> peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.
2 Timothy 2:22	Flee also youthful lusts; but pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.
Titus 1:4	To Titus, a true son in <i>our</i> common faith: Grace, mercy, <i>and</i> peace from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Savior.
Philemon 3	Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
Hebrews 7:2	to whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all, first being translated "king of righteousness," and then also king of Salem, meaning "king of peace,"
Hebrews 11:31	By faith the harlot Rahab did not perish with those who did not believe, when she had received the spies with peace.
Hebrews 12:14	Pursue peace with all <i>people</i> , and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord:
Hebrews 13:20	Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant,
James 2:16	and one of you says to them, "Depart in peace, be warmed and filled," but you do not give them the things which are needed for the body, what <i>does it</i> profit?
James 3:18	Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.
1 Peter 1:2	elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in sanctification of the Spirit, for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace be multiplied.
1 Peter 3:11	Let him turn away from evil and do good; Let him seek peace and pursue it.
1 Peter 5:14	Greet one another with a kiss of love. Peace to you all who are in Christ Jesus. Amen.
2 Peter 1:2	Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord,
2 Peter 3:14	Therefore, beloved, looking forward to these things, be diligent to be found by Him in peace, without spot and blameless;
2 John 3	Grace, mercy, <i>and</i> peace will be with you from God the Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love.
3 John 14	but I hope to see you shortly, and we shall speak face to face. Peace to you. Our friends greet you. Greet the friends by name.
Jude 2	Mercy, peace, and love be multiplied to you.
Revelation 1:4	John, to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace to you and peace from Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven Spirits who are before His throne,
Revelation 6:4	Another horse, fiery red, went out. And it was granted to the one who sat on it to take peace from the earth, and that <i>people</i> should kill one another; and there was given to him a great sword.
